#### **Admission Requirements**

For candidates who obtained their MSCE before 2019, applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with credit passes in English and any two of the following: Mathematics, Biology, and Physical Science. Candidates should have an aggregate of not more than 36 points.

For candidates who obtained their MSCE in 2019 and after, they should have an aggregate of not more than 36 points in their MSCE and must have credits in English and in any of the following subject combinations:

i. Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry (Biology should at least be a pass) ii.

Mathematics and Biology (Physics and Chemistry should at least be passes) iii.

Biology, Physics and Chemistry (Mathematics should at least be a pass)

Note: Applicants must be willing to sign a scholarship service bond to serve within Malawi for a period not less than three years.

## ENTRANCE EXAMINATION AND MODE OF REGISTRATION

Entrance Examinations will be administered on Friday, 30th August, 2024.

Registration for the Entrance Examinations will take place on 28th August – 29th August, 2024 from

i. Southern Region

Malawi College of Health Sciences - Blantyre Campus Malawi College of Health Sciences - Zomba Campus

ii. Central Region Malawi College of Health Sciences - Lilongwe Campus

iii. Northern Region Katoto Secondary School - Mzuzu

Candidates MUST bring the following on the day of registration:

- Original Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent, or original notification of results slip.
- One (1) colour passport-size photograph ii.
- iii. Any form of recognized identity
- Support letter from their employer

Candidates who will not bring any of the four above (i-iv) will not be registered. Candidates should wear face masks on both days of registration and on the day of writing Entrance Examinations. Candidates without face masks will not be entertained. For further information, please contact:
