Admission Requirements

Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with four credit passes which should include:

- i. English
- ii. Biology
- iii. Physical Science or Chemistry or Physics
- iv. Plus any one science subject (either Mathematics, Agriculture, Geography or Home Economics)
- 2. CERTIFICATE IN PHARMACY
- 3. CERTIFICATE IN BIOMEDICAL SCIENCES

Admission Requirements

- Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with credit passes in English and any two of the following: Mathematics, Biology, and Physical Science. Candidates should have an aggregate of not more than 36 points. These requirements are for candidates that obtained their MSCE before 2019.
- Those who obtained their MSCE in 2019 and after should have an aggregate of not more than 36 points in their MSCE and must have credits in English and in any of the following subject combinations:
 - Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry (Biology should at least be a pass)
 - ii. Mathematics and Biology (Physics and Chemistry should at least be passes)
 - iii. Biology, Physics and Chemistry (Mathematics should at least be a pass)

Entrance Examinations will be administered on Friday, 30th August, 2024.

The Bank Deposit Slip should strictly bear the name of the candidate.

The Registration Fee is non-refundable. Candidates should, therefore, make sure that they qualify for their preferred courses before depositing the Registration fees into the College's Bank Account.

Prospective candidates are advised to keep the bank deposit slip and bring it for registration (on 28^{th} August -29^{th} August, 2024) at any of the Registration Centres. Registration forms will be obtained on the registration day in all the registration centres.

Candidates MUST bring the following on the day of registration:

- i. Bank Certified Deposit Slip strictly bearing the name of the candidate
- ii. Original Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent, or original notification of results slip.
- iii. One (1) colour passport-size photograph
- iv. Any form of recognized identity

Candidates who will not bring any of the four above (i - iv) will not be registered. Candidates should wear face masks on both days of registration and on the day of writing Entrance Examinations. Candidates without face masks will not be entertained.
