TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES – APRIL 2024 INTAKE

Malawi College of Health Sciences wishes to inform the public that it has training opportunities for basic courses in the 2023-2024 Academic Year. The courses are open to both male and female applicants with a minimum age of 16 and a maximum age of 45.

Admission Requirements for courses 1 - 7

Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with credit passes in English, Mathematics, Physical Science and Biology. Those who obtained their MSCE after 2018 should have credits in English, Biology, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry. All candidates must have an aggregate of not more than 30 points in MSCE or its equivalent.

8. *Diploma in Nursing (Registered Nursing) - Scholarships: None*

Duration: 3 years - Blantyre Campus

Admission Requirements

Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with six credits. The credit passes must be in English, Mathematics, Biology, Physical Science and any other two subjects. Those who obtained their MSCE after 2018 should have credits in English, Biology, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and another credit in any other subject.

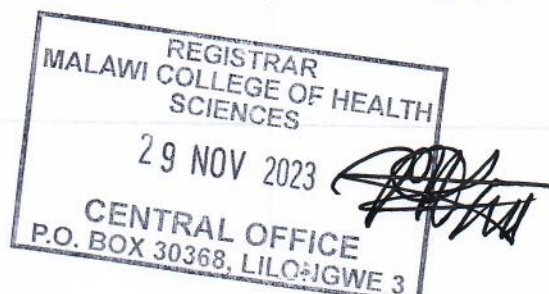
9. *Diploma in Nursing (Nursing & Midwifery Technician) – Scholarships: None*

Duration: 3 years - Zomba Campus

Admission Requirements

Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with four credit passes which should include:

- i. English
- ii. Biology
- iii. Physical Science or Chemistry or Physics
- iv. Plus any one science subject (either Mathematics, Agriculture, Geography or Home Economics)

10. *Certificate in Clinical Medicine (Blantyre and Lilongwe Campuses)*

11. *Certificate in Pharmacy (Lilongwe Campus)*

Duration: 2 years

Admission Requirements

Applicants that sat for their MSCE before the introduction of Physics and Chemistry must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) of not more than 36 points or its equivalent with **Credit passes** in English and any of the following subject combinations:

- i. Mathematics and Physical Science (Biology should at least be a pass)
- ii. Mathematics and Biology (Physical Science should at least be a pass)
- iii. Biology and Physical Science (Mathematics should at least be a pass)

Those who obtained their MSCE after 2018 should have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) of not more than 36 points or its equivalent with **Credit passes** in English and any of the following subject combinations:

- i. Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry (Biology should atleast be a pass)
- ii. Mathematics and Biology (Physics and Chemistry should atleast be passes)
- iii. Biology, Physics and Chemistry (Mathematics should at least be a pass)

12. *Certificate in Community Midwifery Assistant - Zomba Campus*

Duration: 18 Months

– *Scholarships: 80 from Ministry of Health with funding from
Global Health*

Admission Requirements:

Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with a pass in either Biology or Physical Science. Candidates who do not have a pass in either Biology or Physical Science should have passes in Physics and Chemistry.

ENTRANCE EXAMINATION AND MODE OF REGISTRATION

Entrance Examinations will be administered on 19th January, 2024, from 7:30AM.

Registration for the Entrance Examinations will take place on 17th and 18th January, 2024 from 7:30AM at the following Registration Centres:

a) *Southern Region*

Malawi College of Health Sciences – Blantyre Campus

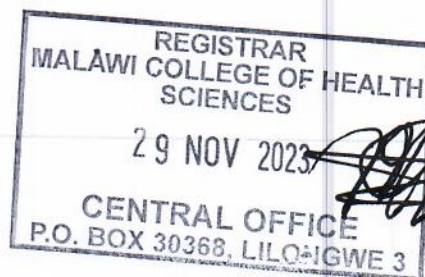

Registration Fee for the Entrance Examinations should be paid in advance on any day from 28th November, 2023 – 19th January, 2024. Registration fee is K15, 000.00 payable at any NBS Branch into the following account:

The Bank Deposit Slip should strictly bear the name of the candidate.

The Registration Fee is non-refundable. Candidates should, therefore, make sure that they qualify for their preferred courses before depositing the Registration fees into the College's Bank Account. No refunds will be made to non-qualifying candidates who deposit registration fees into College Account.

Prospective candidates are advised to keep the bank deposit slip and bring it for registration (on 17th January, 2024 – 18th January, 2024) at any of the Registration Centres. Registration forms will be obtained on the registration day in all the registration centres.

Candidates **MUST** bring the following to the registration centre on the day of registration:

- i. Bank Certified Deposit Slip **strictly** bearing the name of the candidate
- ii. Original Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent, or original notification of results slip.
- iii. One (1) colour passport size photograph
- iv. Any form of recognized identity (National ID, Passport, Driver's License, MANEB Student Examination ID)

Candidates who will not bring any of the four above (i – iv) will not be registered.

Please note that limited scholarships (80) MAY be available to successful eligible candidates applying for a Certificate in Community Midwifery Assistant.
