## 2024 SECOND SELECTION – DIPLOMA IN ANAESTHESIA AND INTENSIVE CARE MEDICINE

Malawi College of Health Sciences (MCHS) is pleased to announce names of successful candidates who have been selected to pursue a course in Diploma in Anaesthesia and Intensive Care Medicine at both Lilongwe and Blantyre Campuses in the 2024/2025 Academic Year on Second Selection. All selected candidates are expected to report for classes by Monday, 22st July, 2024. However, candidates, parents, guardians and sponsors need to know that any selection of students at MCHS is subject to a physical verification of their individual (candidate's) qualifications by their respective Head of Programme at the College and the Malawi national examination Board (MANEB).

All candidates have been selected on self sponsorship and will be required to pay a total of MK600,000.00 per Semester. Candidates, parents and guardians are informed that the fees may increase anytime within the academic year. All selected candidates must pay at least half their fees in the College Account before registration. Candidates that will report before paying their fees will not be registered.

Limited space for accommodation might be available at the Campuses but candidates need to apply in advance for the same at the campuses. The minimum accommodation fee is K25,000 per bed per month payable in advance for the whole semester. Candidates should not deposit accommodation fees until their respective campuses approve their applications. Accommodation forms can be obtained free of charge from any of our campuses or can be downloaded from our website www.mchs.mw. Priority will be given to those applying early and showing proof of paying at least half of their tuition fees.
