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**OPENING ARRANGEMENTS FOR CONTINUING STUDENTS AT MALAWI COLLEGE OF HEALTH SCIENCES**

Malawi College of Health Sciences (MCHS) wishes to inform all continuing students in all the campuses that the opening date of school is Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2021. Students should therefore report at their respective campuses on the same day, Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2021. Students who fail to report for classes at the expiry of one week from the day of opening will have their places forfeited as stipulated in the College's Rules and Regulations.

**School Fees**

College Management wishes to inform all students that, with effect from the 2021/22 academic year, all students will be on non – residential basis and therefore tuition fees in the 2021/22 academic year are K550,000.00 per year for Basic Programmes and K751,000.00 per year for Post Basic Programmes. Students should pay at least half of their tuition fees in advance into the College's bank account at Standard Bank and bring their deposit slips on the opening day. Students will not be allowed to access any service offered by the College if they do not pay the required amount of fees.

**Food for Students**

The College will no longer be providing food to students from the College kitchen. Arrangements are being made for students to be buying food from private caterers who will be supplying food at a fee on daily basis.

**Accommodation for Students**

There will be limited space for student accommodation in all campuses. Students who require to be accommodated on campus are advised to apply for it (accommodation) at their respective campuses. Priority will be given to those that will apply early and will show proof of payment of school fees for the academic year. The minimum accommodation fee is K15,000.00 per bed per month payable in advance for the whole semester in the respective **Campus Bank Accounts**. Students should not deposit accommodation fees, unless their applications have been considered favourably by their respective campuses. ### **End of Year Examination Results**

### **Arrangements for Some Students that are still on Campus**

The College is aware that there are some students at Lilongwe, Zomba and Blantyre Campuses whose academic calendar is different from the normal College Calendar and hence their academic year will still be in progress by the time the College ceases to provide board and lodging services as one package with teaching and learning. The College therefore wishes to inform such students that arrangements will be made to do some calculations and refund everything due to the student for board and lodging. The College will be interested in tuition fees only.

### **Government Sponsored Students**

Third Year students and some repeating second-year students are the only ones whose tuition fees will be paid by Malawi Government as they are the only ones on Government sponsorship. Tuition and accommodation fees for such students will be paid by the Government. Government-sponsored students, therefore, will be required to use their contribution fees to buy food throughout the academic year.

### **Students on Other Scholarships**

The College wishes to inform students whose sponsors had paid their tuition fees in advance for the 2021/22 academic year that necessary calculations and arrangements for refund will be made, so that the students should buy food using the refunded money. In subsequent academic years, the College will only be collecting tuition fees from the sponsors. Any other arrangements regarding accommodation and food should be between the students and their sponsors.
