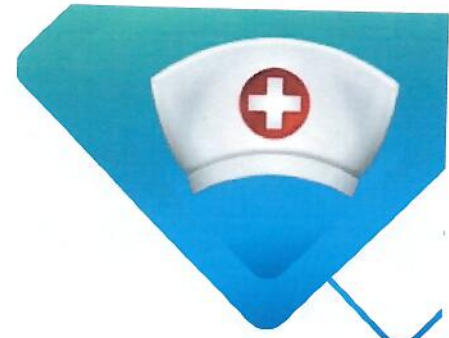

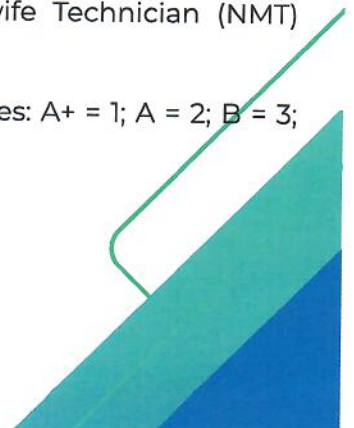
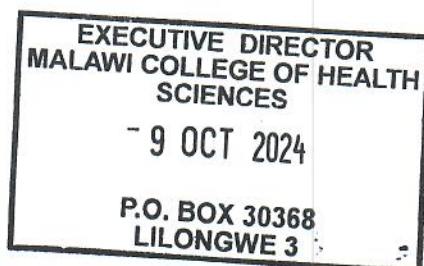
1	Duration:	3 Years
2	Scholarships:	MCHS-HRH Project with funding from USAID
3	Number of Scholarships	50 (shall provide tuition fees & upkeep based on Project's approved budget and Work-Plan)
4	Eligibility	Applicants must be serving Nurse Midwife Technicians with a minimum of 4 years experience

ADMISSION REQUIRMENTS:

Applicants must have:

- An MSCE/IGSCE or other internationally recognised qualification comparable to MSCE or 'O' level certificates with at least six credits. The **credit passes** must be in English, Mathematics, Biology, Physical Science and any other two subjects. Those who obtained their MSCE after 2018 should have **credits** in English, Biology, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and another credit in any other subject. In both cases the aggregate points should not be more than 30.
- A College Diploma in Nursing and Midwifery Technician or its equivalent from an accredited institution,
- Current registration with the Nurses and Midwives Council of Malawi,
- A minimum of 4 years clinical working experience post Nurse Midwife Technician (NMT) qualification.

Note: The following is the interpretation of IGCSE results for admission purposes: A+ = 1; A = 2; B = 3; C = 4, 5; D = 7; EFG = 8

The application should include an application letter, a detailed Curriculum Vitae with valid email addresses, scanned copies of the bank deposit slip, letter from employer and certified copies of certificates to admissions@mchs.mw or through the address below:

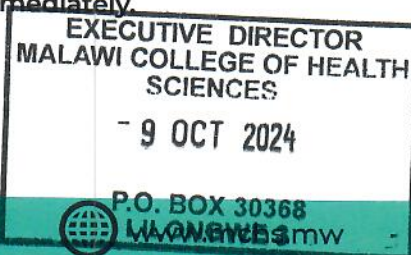
