

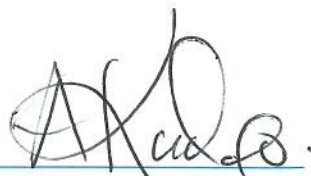

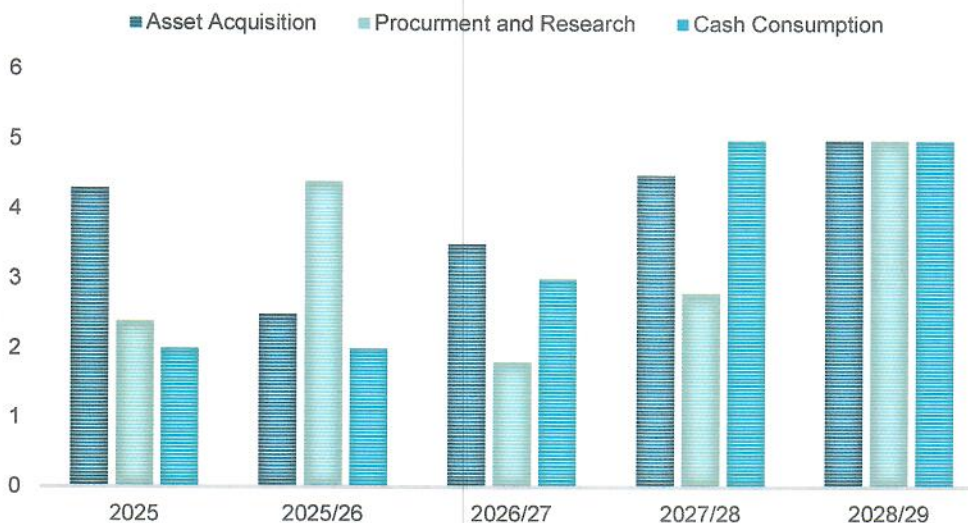

DONOR FUND DISTRIBUTION



The initial cash injection will result in investment of 42% of the cash towards Asset Acquisition that will incrementally increase the quality of service for the college. 25% of the fund will be expounded for IT procurement in the main and critical research toward enhancement of technical capabilities of the college. This is intended expenditure framework is cautioned by exogenous economic condition and pursuant sustainable funding for the MCHS Strategic Plan 2024 - 2029.

Malawi College of Health Sciences (MCHS) was established in 1996 through a Parliamentary Education Order with the purpose of training and developing health workers in Malawi. MCHS is a semi-subservent parastatal organisation whose mandate is to train health-care professionals that form a vital component of Malawi Government's plans to improve the health of the nation's population. MCHS produces approximately 1,000 graduates each year, equipped with the technical skills necessary to contribute effectively to the country's health sector

MCHS Strategic Plan Resource Mobilisation is guided by the following policies, The Public Service Management Guidelines as prescribed by the Constitution of the Republic of Malawi of 1994, including legal instruments such as the Public Service Act 1994, the Public Finance Management Act 2003, the Public Procurement and Disposal of Assets 2016, the Public Audit Act 2003 and the Local Government Act 1998.
