1. Bachelor of Science in Clinical Medicine – Lilongwe Campus

Admissions Requirements

Applicants must have an MSCE or IGCSE or other internationally recognised qualification comparable to 'O' level certificate with at least six credit passes obtained from 2020 to the current year. The credit passes must be in English, Mathematics, Biology, Physics, Chemistry and any other subject. Candidates should also have a minimum of 4 points in each of the following subjects: Biology, Physics and Chemistry at MSCE or 'C' at IGCSE. The following is the interpretation of IGCSE results for admission purposes: A+ = 1; A = 2; B = 3; C = 4,5; D = 7; EFG = 8

2. Diploma in Clinical Medicine – Lilongwe and Blantyre Campuses

Admissions Requirements

Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent. Applicants who obtained their qualifications before 2018 must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent, with credit passes in English, Mathematics, Physical Science, and Biology. Those who obtained their MSCE after 2018 should have **credits** in English, Biology, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry. All candidates must have an aggregate of 30 points or less in MSCE or its equivalent.

3. Diploma in Nursing and Midwifery Technician – Zomba Campuses

Admissions Requirements

Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with **four credit passes**, which should include:



- i. English
- ii. Biology
- iii. Physical Science or Chemistry or Physics
- iv. Plus any one science subject (either Mathematics, Agriculture, Geography or Home Economics)

4. Certificate in Clinical Medicine – Lilongwe and Blantyre Campuses

Admissions Requirements

i. For applicants who obtained MSCE before the introduction of Physics and Chemistry as separate subjects:

Must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with a maximum of 36 points. They must have Credit passes in English and any one of the following subject combinations:

1. Mathematics and Physical Science (with at least a pass in Biology)
2. Mathematics and Biology (with at least a pass in Physical Science)
3. Biology and Physical Science (with at least a pass in Mathematics)

ii. For applicants who obtained MSCE in 2018 or later:

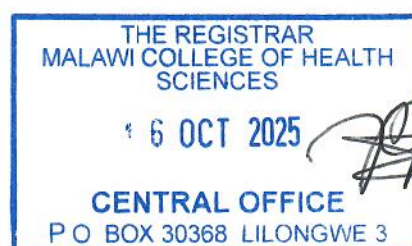
Must have an MSCE or its equivalent with no more than 36 points. They must have Credit passes in English and any one of the following subject combinations:

1. Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry (with at least a pass in Biology)
2. Mathematics and Biology (with at least passes in Physics and Chemistry)
3. Biology, Physics, and Chemistry (with at least a pass in Mathematics)

Interested applicants are required to submit their applications **exclusively** through the following online portal: admissions.mchs.mw. Please note that applications submitted via post or email will not be accepted. The application should include an application letter, a detailed Curriculum Vitae with valid email addresses, scanned copies of the bank deposit slip, and **certified** copies of certificates.
