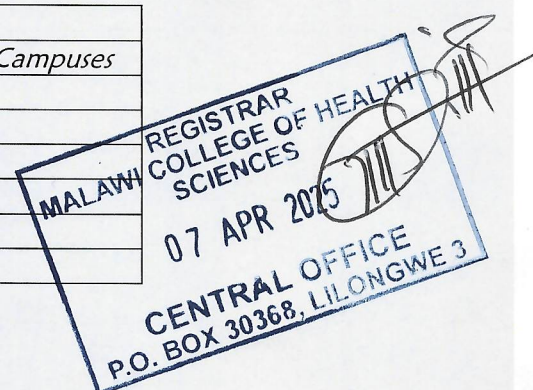

The Malawi College of Health Sciences invites applications from suitably qualified candidates, both male and female, for admission into its Economic Fee-Paying programmes for the 2025/2026 academic year. These programmes are open to individuals interested in pursuing studies under the Economic Fee category in the disciplines listed below.

Admission Requirements for Courses 1 - 7

Applicants who obtained their qualifications in 2018 or before must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent, with credit passes in English, Mathematics, Physical Science, and Biology. Those who obtained their MSCE after 2018 should have **credits** in English, Biology, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry. All candidates must have an aggregate of 30 points or less in MSCE or its equivalent.

8. Diploma in Nursing (Registered Nursing)

Duration: 3 years - Blantyre Campus

Admission Requirements

Applicants who got their qualifications in 2018 or before must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with **six credits**. The **credit passes** must be in English, Mathematics, Biology, Physical Science and any other two subjects. Those who obtained their MSCE after 2018 should have **credits** in English, Biology, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and another credit in any other subject.

9. Diploma in Nursing (Nursing & Midwifery Technician)

Duration: 3 years - Zomba Campus

Admission Requirements

Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with **four credit passes**, which should include:

- i. English
- ii. Biology
- iii. Physical Science or Chemistry or Physics
- iv. Plus any one science subject (either Mathematics, Agriculture, Geography or Home Economics)

CERTIFICATE COURSES

10. Certificate in Clinical Medicine (Blantyre and Lilongwe Campuses)

11. Certificate in Pharmacy (Lilongwe Campus)

Duration: 2 years

Admission Requirements

For applicants who completed their MSCE before the introduction of Physics and Chemistry as separate subjects:

Such applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with a maximum of 36 points. They must have Credit passes in English and any one of the following subject combinations:

1. Mathematics and Physical Science (with at least a pass in Biology)
2. Mathematics and Biology (with at least a pass in Physical Science)
3. Biology and Physical Science (with at least a pass in Mathematics)

For applicants who completed their MSCE in 2018 or before:

Such applicants must have an MSCE or its equivalent with no more than 36 points. They must have Credit passes in English and any one of the following subject combinations:

1. Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry (with at least a pass in Biology)
2. Mathematics and Biology (with at least passes in Physics and Chemistry)
3. Biology, Physics, and Chemistry (with at least a pass in Mathematics)

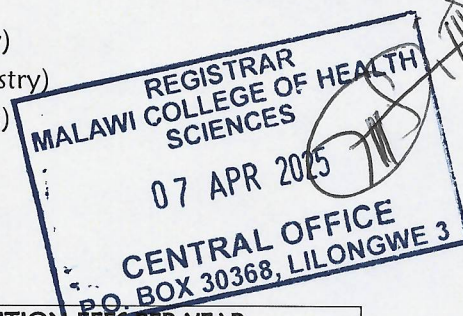
TUITION FEES

Interested applicants are required to submit their applications **exclusively** through the following online portal: admissions.mchs.mw Please note that applications submitted via post or email will not be accepted. The



application should include an application letter, a detailed Curriculum Vitae with valid email addresses, scanned copies of the bank deposit slip, and **certified** copies of certificates.

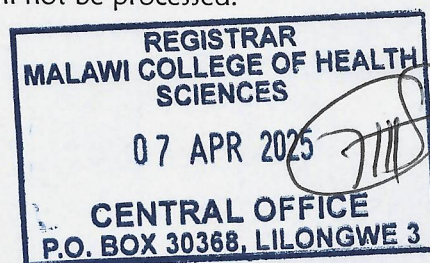
