

CENTRAL OFFICE PRESS RELEASE TRAINING AND SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES (BASIC AND POST-BASIC PROGRAMMES) – NOVEMBER 2025/2026 INTAKE

The Malawi College of Health Sciences (MCHS) has secured scholarships under THE PRESIDENTIAL INITIATIVE FOR MATERNAL HEALTH and is inviting applications for admission into the following programmes for the October/November 2025 intake:

- Diploma in Anaesthesia and Intensive Care Medicine
- Diploma in Community Health Nursing (Upgrading)
- Certificate in Community Midwife Assistant

NOTE: Candidates who previously responded to the earlier advert for these programmes should not submit another application.

1. Diploma in Anaesthesia and Intensive Care Medicine (Blantyre and Lilongwe): 18 Months

Admission Requirements

Applicants must be qualified Medical Assistants or Nurse Midwife Technicians who have served for a minimum of two years. Applicants must also have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with a credit pass in English. Candidates must have passes in the following subjects: Mathematics, Biology and Physical Science (Physics and Chemistry). Two of these must be credit passes. Applicants must be registered with the Medical Council of Malawi or the Nurses and Midwives Council of Malawi.

2. Diploma in Community Health Nursing - Upgrading (Lilongwe, Blantyre and Zomba): 12 Months

Admission Requirements

Applicants must be qualified Nursing Midwifery Technicians with a minimum of 2 years' experience and currently registered with the Nurses and Midwives Council of Malawi. Applicants must also have a Malawi School Certificate of Education or its equivalent.

3. Certificate in Community Midwifery Assistant (Lilongwe, Blantyre and Zomba): 18 Months

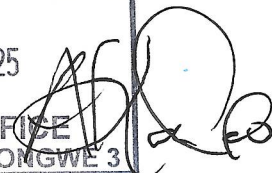
Admission Requirements:

Applicants should be those with credit passes in English and Biology and passes in either Mathematics, Science, Physical Science, Chemistry and Physics

METHOD OF APPLICATION

Please take note that Malawi College of Health Sciences NO LONGER ADMINISTERS ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS; thus, all prospective interested applicants are required to submit their applications through the following online portal: admissions.mchs.mw. Applicants unable to use the online portal may submit their applications by post or email. All applications must include the following:

i. Generic Applications:

Applicants are required to submit an application letter, a certified copy of the MSCE certificate, a detailed Curriculum Vitae with a valid email address, a copy of a national ID, and scanned copies of the bank deposit slip strictly bearing the name of the applicant.

ii. Upgrading Applications:

Applicants should submit an application letter, a stamped letter from their employer, a detailed Curriculum Vitae with valid email addresses, scanned copies of the bank deposit slip strictly bearing the name of the applicant, a certified copy of the MSCE certificate, certified copies of professional qualifications obtained from recognised institutions, and proof of registration with the relevant regulatory body.

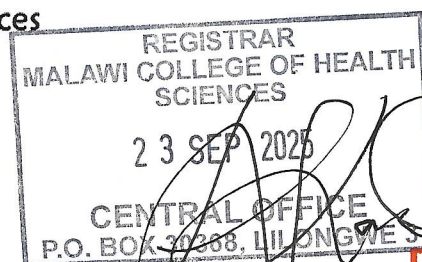

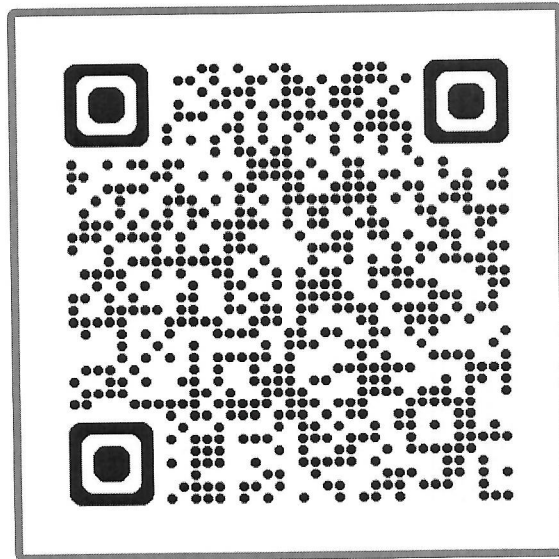

Candidates who would submit Certificates that have not been notarised by a certified authority will also be disqualified. Please note that Malawi College of Health Sciences has stopped conducting Entrance Examinations. Candidates should therefore simply submit their applications.
