PROGRAMMES WHOSE PREVIOUSLY SCHEDULED OPENING DATE WAS DEFERRED**

The Malawi College of Health Sciences wishes to inform candidates admitted to the following programmes, whose previously scheduled opening date was deferred, that the revised opening date for the 2026/2027 academic year is Monday, 5th October 2026:

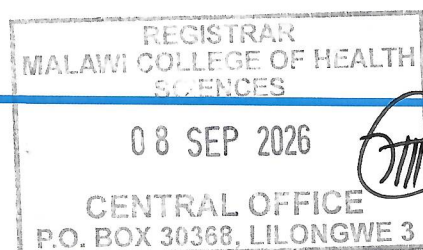
1. Diploma in Community Health Nursing and Midwifery – Self-Sponsorship;
2. Certificate in Midwifery Assistant – PIMH Scholarship; and
3. Diploma in Clinical Medicine – Self-Sponsorship.

All concerned candidates are required to report to their respective campuses on Monday, 5th October 2026 and make the necessary arrangements to commence their studies.

Candidates admitted to the Certificate in Midwifery Assistant programme under the Presidential Initiative for Maternal Health (PIMH) are reminded that the scholarship covers tuition fees only. Any additional support, including a modest allowance, may be provided by the Ministry of Health and Sanitation, subject to applicable arrangements and confirmation.

Parents and guardians are therefore responsible for providing their wards with all other personal and academic requirements as specified in the offer letters.

Accommodation arrangements: Limited on-campus accommodation may be available. Candidates wishing to secure accommodation are advised to apply in advance through their respective campuses. The minimum accommodation fee is MK50,000.00 per bed per month, payable in full for the entire semester. Candidates are strongly advised not to make any accommodation payments until they have received formal approval from the College. Accommodation application forms are available free-of-charge at all MCHS campuses and can also be downloaded from the College website: www.mchs.mw



All candidates allocated to Lilongwe Campus are required to apply for accommodation through the online portal: hostelms.mchs.mw Candidates should use their reference numbers and the password provided in their offer letters to access the system. Please note that access to the accommodation portal will only be granted upon payment of at least 50% of the tuition fees for self-sponsored students.
