TRAINING OPPORTUNITY FOR A UNIVERSITY CERTIFICATE IN MIDWIFERY – APRIL 2026 INTAKE

Malawi College of Health Sciences is inviting applications from suitably qualified male and female candidates to pursue face-to-face training for a University Certificate in Midwifery in the 2026-2027 Academic Year at Blantyre Campus. The programmes are open to both male and female applicants with a minimum age of 16 and a maximum age of 50.

Admission Requirements for University Certificate in Midwifery (Post Basic)

Candidates for admission into the Midwifery programme must:

Have diploma or degree in Registered Nursing obtained from a recognized institution, and Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with 6 credits. Four (4) of the credit passes must be in the following subjects: English, Mathematics, Biology and Physical Science or Physics and Chemistry. Two (2) of the credit passes must be in any 2 subjects.

Be registered with Nurses and Midwives Council of Malawi with a current practicing license.

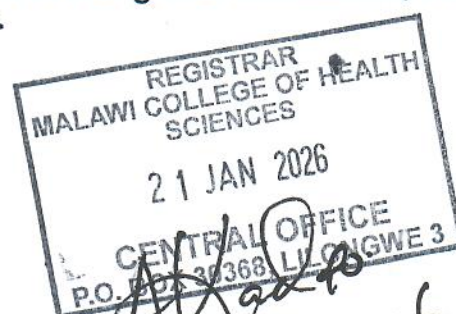
APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Please take note that Malawi College of Health Sciences **NO LONGER ADMINISTERS ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS**; thus all prospective candidates are required to submit their applications through the following online portal: admissions.mchs.mw. Applicants who are unable to use the online portal may submit their applications by post or email. All applications must include the following:

an application letter, registration form, a stamped letter from their employer, a detailed Curriculum Vitae with valid email addresses, scanned copies of the bank deposit slip strictly bearing the name of the applicant, a certified copy of the MSCE certificate, certified copies of professional qualifications obtained from recognized institutions, and proof of registration with the relevant regulatory body.

Candidates should therefore simply submit their applications.**
