

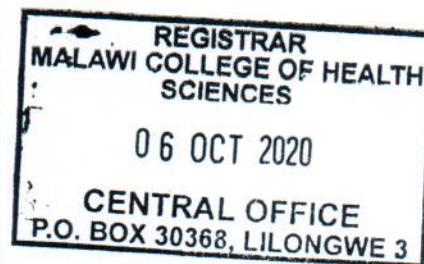


Malawi College of Health Sciences

TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

Malawi College of Health Sciences is pleased to announce training opportunities for basic courses in the 2020-2021 academic year. The courses are open to both male and female applicants with a minimum age of 16 and a maximum age of 40.

<i>DIPLOMA COURSES</i>	-	<i>DURATION: 3 YEARS</i>
1. <i>Clinical Medicine</i>	-	<i>Lilongwe & Blantyre Campuses</i>
2. <i>Dental Therapy</i>	-	<i>Lilongwe Campus</i>
3. <i>Biomedical Sciences</i>	-	<i>Lilongwe Campus</i>
4. <i>Environmental Health</i>	-	<i>Lilongwe Campus</i>
5. <i>Radiography</i>	-	<i>Lilongwe Campus</i>
6. <i>Pharmacy</i>	-	<i>Lilongwe Campus</i>
7. <i>Optometry</i>	-	<i>Lilongwe Campus</i>



Admission Requirements for courses 1 - 7

Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with **credit passes** in English, Mathematics, Physical Science and Biology. Those who obtained their MSCE in 2019 should have **credits** in English, Biology, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry. Candidates must have an aggregate of not more than **30 points** in MSCE or its equivalent.

8. *Diploma in Nursing (Registered Nursing)*

Duration: 3 years – Blantyre Campus

Admission Requirements

Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with **six credits**. The **credit passes** must be in English, Mathematics, Biology, Physical Science and any two subjects. Those who obtained their MSCE in 2019 should have **credits** in English, Biology, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, and any credit in any subject.

9. *Diploma in Nursing (Nursing & Midwifery Technician)*

Duration: 3 years - Zomba Campus

Admission Requirements

Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with **six credit passes** which should include English, Physical Science, Biology and any other science subject (either Agriculture, Home Economics or Geography) plus any other 2 subjects. Those who obtained their MSCE in 2019 should have **credits** in English, Biology, Physics, Chemistry and any science subject (either Agriculture, Home Economics or Geography) plus any other 2 subjects.

Note: In both scenarios, if **Mathematics** is not a credit, it must be a strong pass of **Seven (7)**.

CERTIFICATE COURSE

10. Certificate in Clinical Medicine (2 years, Blantyre and Lilongwe Campuses)

Admission Requirements

Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with **credit passes** in English and any two of the following: Mathematics, Biology, and Physical Science. Candidates should have an aggregate of not more than 36 points. Those who obtained their MSCE in 2019 should have an aggregate of not more than 36 points in their MSCE and must have **credits** in English and in any of the following subject combinations:

- i. Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry
- ii. Mathematics and Biology
- iii. Biology, Physics and Chemistry

ENTRANCE EXAMINATION AND MODE OF REGISTRATION

Entrance Examinations will be administered on 18th November, 2020 from 7:30AM.

Prospective candidates should register on 16th – 17th November, 2020 from 7:30AM at the following Registration Centres:

a) Southern Region

Malawi College of Health Sciences – Blantyre Campus

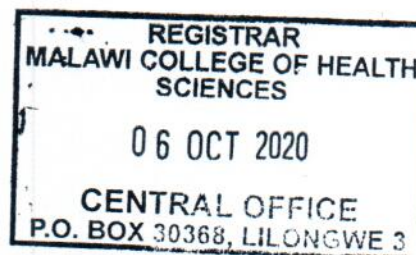
Malawi College of Health Sciences – Zomba Campus

b) Central Region

Malawi College of Health Sciences – Lilongwe Campus

c) Northern Region

Katoto Secondary School – Mzuzu



Registration Fee for the Entrance Examinations should be paid in advance on any day from 6th October, 2020 to 17th November, 2020. Registration fee is K12, 000.00 payable at any **FDH Branch** into the following account:

The Bank Deposit Slip should **strictly** bear the name of the candidate.

The Registration Fee is **non-refundable**. Candidates should, therefore, **make sure that they qualify** for their preferred courses before depositing the Entrance Examination Fees into the College's Bank Account.

Prospective candidates are advised to keep the bank deposit slip and bring it for registration on 16th and 17th November, 2020 at any of the Registration Centres. Registration forms will be obtained on the registration day in all the registration centres.

Candidates **MUST** bring the following on the day of registration:

- i. Bank Certified Deposit Slip **strictly** bearing the name of the candidate

- ii. Original Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent, or notification of results slip.
- iii. One (1) colour passport size photograph
- iv. Identity Card

Candidates who will **not** bring any of the four above (i – iv) will not be registered. Candidates should wear **face masks** on both days of registration and on the day of writing Entrance Examinations. Candidates without **face masks** will not be entertained.

Please note that limited scholarships MAY be available to successful eligible candidates.
